



- The Department of Recreation, Parks and Cultural Activities is proposing to modify tennis courts in five locations to create multiuse tennis and pickleball court facilities.
- Pickleball facilities will overlay two courts on a single tennis court and utilize movable pickleball nets. In one location where this configuration is not feasible, a single pickleball court will be overlaid on the tennis courts and use the tennis nets.
- Recommended locations include Armistead L. Boothe Park, Chambliss Park, Chinquapin Park, Lee Center, and Eugene Simpson Park



Project History



- 2016 The tennis courts at Lee Center were converted to multiuse and lined for pickleball.
- 2019 The tennis court at Mount Vernon was converted to multiuse and lined for pickleball.
- 2019 Pickleball advocates approached the City about additional opportunities to expand play in Alexandria
- 2020 Staff met with pickleball advocates and toured facilities in the region to identify best practices and review additional multiuse court layouts.
- 2021 Staff requested and received additional funding to expand pickleball facilities on existing tennis courts.
- 2022 Current community engagement regarding pickleball facility locations.

Pickleball Court Location Selection




Locations for expanded pickleball facilities were selected based on a series of criteria applied in three stages.

Only tennis courts under City of Alexandria control were considered for pickleball facilities.

- Stage 1 Court Characteristics
 - Number of possible courts
 - Available parking
 - Restroom access
 - Lighting
- Stage 2 Equitable Distribution Across Alexandria
- Stage 3 Coordination with renovations planned in the Department Capital Improvement Program (CIP)



Written Comments



Staff posted information online and at the courts proposed for pickleball facilities

Staff received comments from 26 individuals regarding the expansion project

- 76% in favor
- 16% against
- 8% neutral

Concerns

- Reduced access for tennis use on site high use courts
- Confusion during play due to multiple lines
- Noise

Support

- Additional courts for play/expanded use
- Appropriate height nets for pickleball

Project Timing and Next Steps



- The project is currently in planning and design
- Project funding is additional operating money and must be spent in FY2022.
- If approved, staff will engage contractors and vendors for May/June completion at all sites.
- Implementation may be staggered to minimize disruption to court users and align with existing CIP projects planned for Spring 2022.


